- Interactions with senior faculty and committee members helped foster open communication and mentorship.

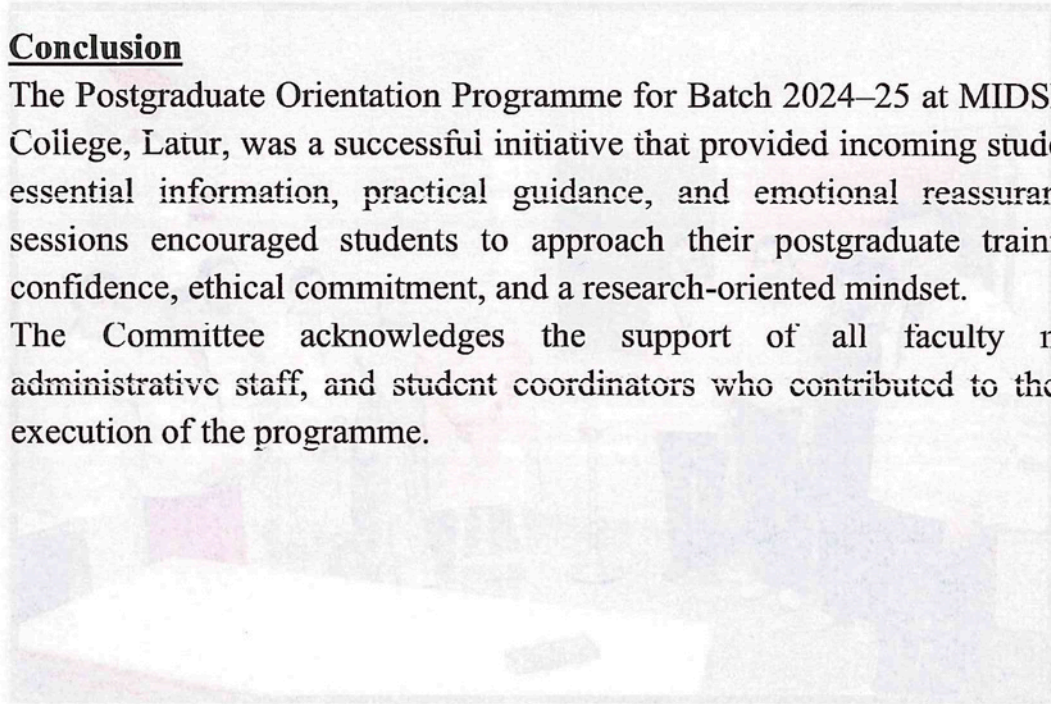


- Awareness about academic policies, ethical obligations, and digital tools prepared students to engage responsibly and professionally from day one.

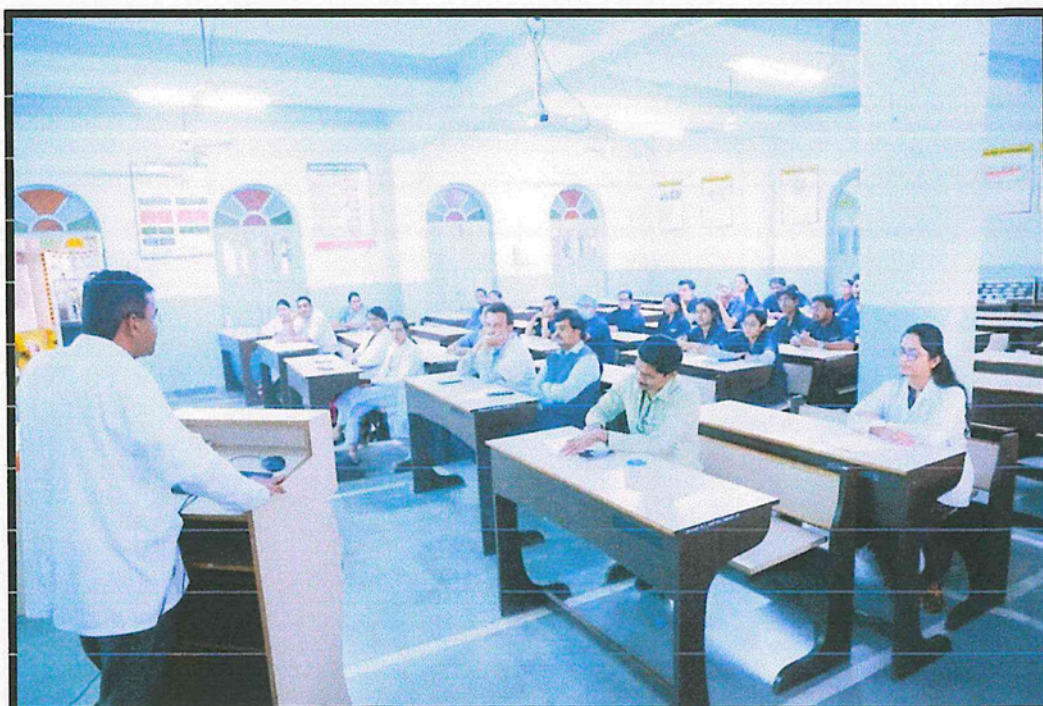

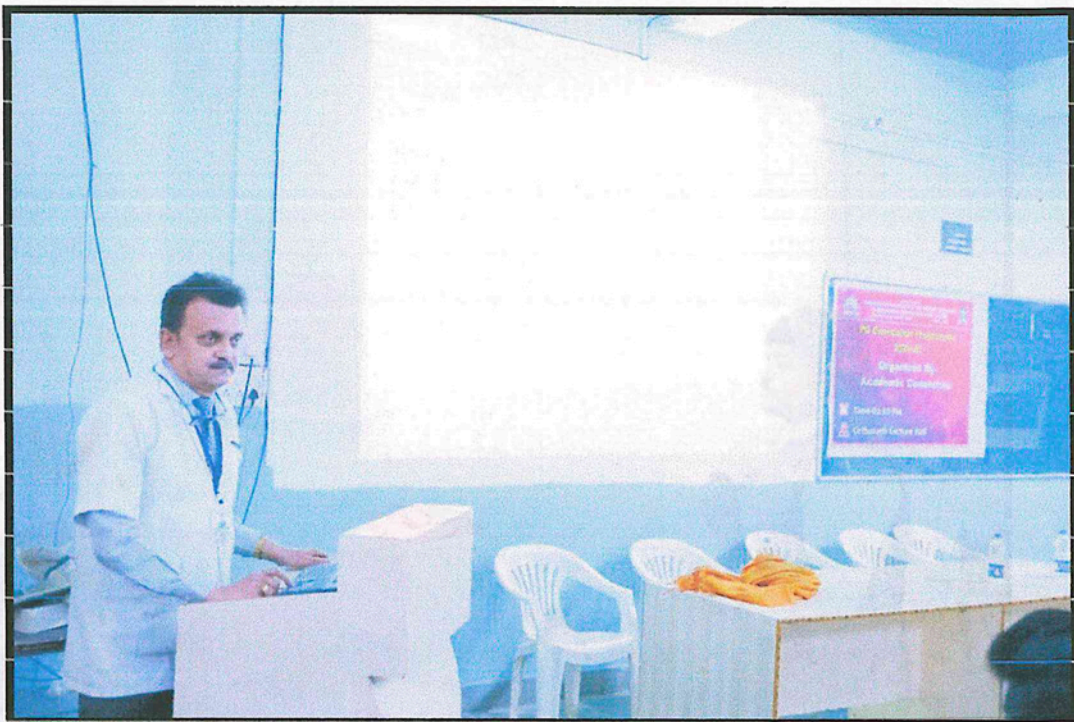

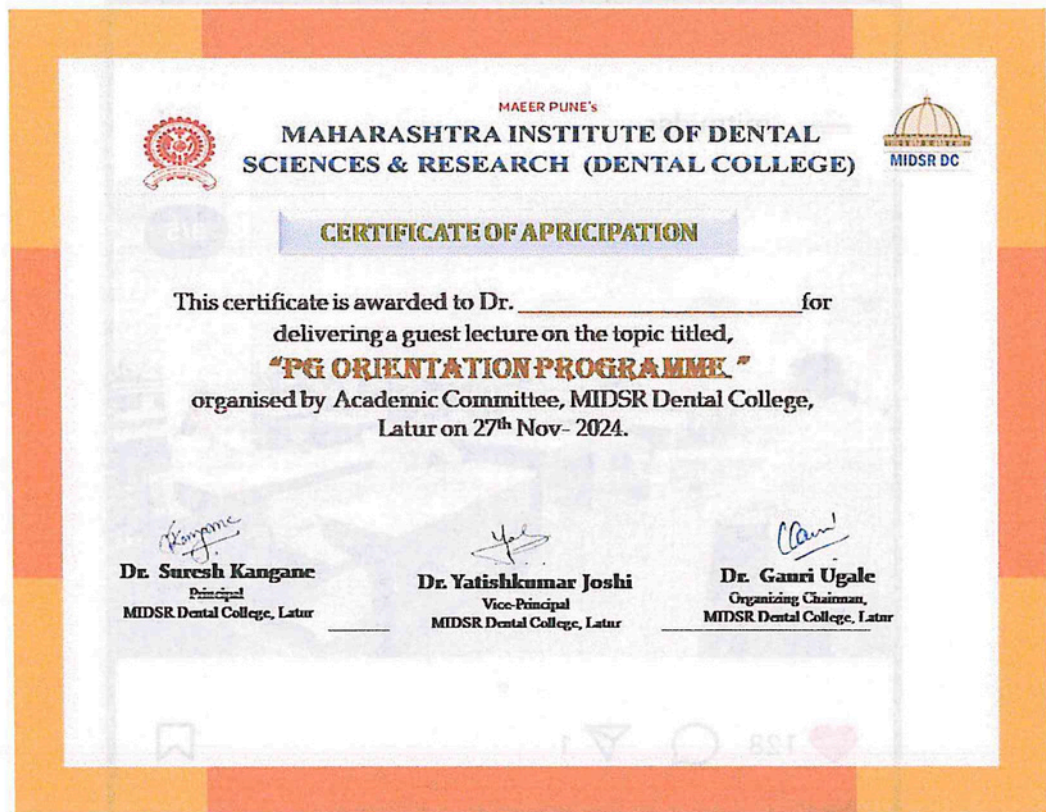
