4. Conclusion:

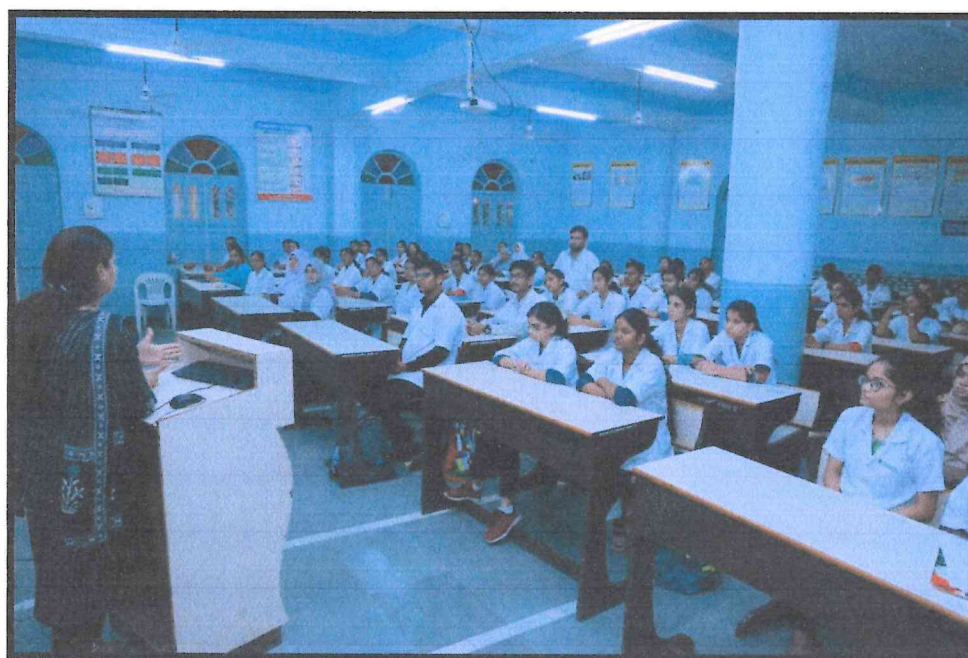
